
Audrain County Shelter Resource Coalition (ACSRC) UPDATE

The Audrain County Shelter Resource Coalition was developed in 2014 to address the needs of homeless individuals and families in the county. Since that time, the coalition has implemented a Winter Shelter program known as "Room at the Inn" that provides safe housing for those facing homelessness during a 3-month time period in the winter months. The coalition will now focus on efforts to develop and maintain a permanent 12-month shelter within the county.

- Audrain County does not have a permanent brick and mortar <u>12 month shelter</u> for families and individuals who are experiencing homelessness/displacement or who are in need of emergency shelter services
- This is the third year that the shelter has opened at the beginning of December. The shelter stays open until the end of February. Due to COVID restrictions, only 9 beds are available at the site compared to 15 in previous years.
- Since December 2020 to February 1st 2021, RATI has sheltered 36 individuals and families and 387 bed nights. Pre-packaged meals, drinks and snacks are made available to those who stay in the shelter.
- Numerous collaborations and partnerships are required to implement and maintain this service to the county each year for the 3
 month period. The ACSRC hired three part-time staff to help manage and staff the site. Due to COVID concerns, the number of
 volunteers utilized was greatly reduced this year.
- The ACSRC signed a 3 year rent agreement on a site in the hope of providing a static location while future plans for a larger site
 can be developed and implemented.








