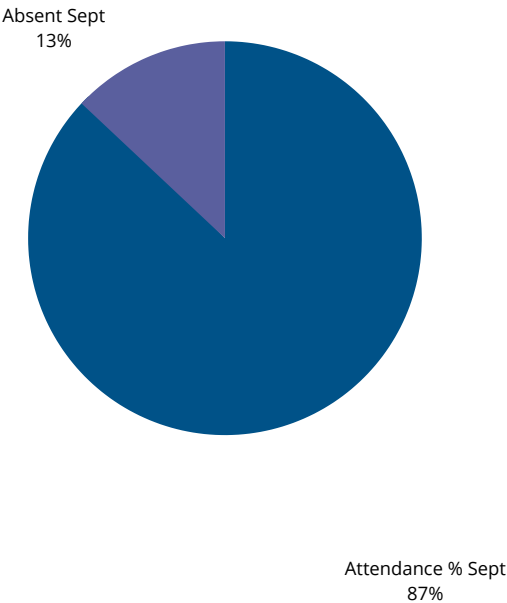

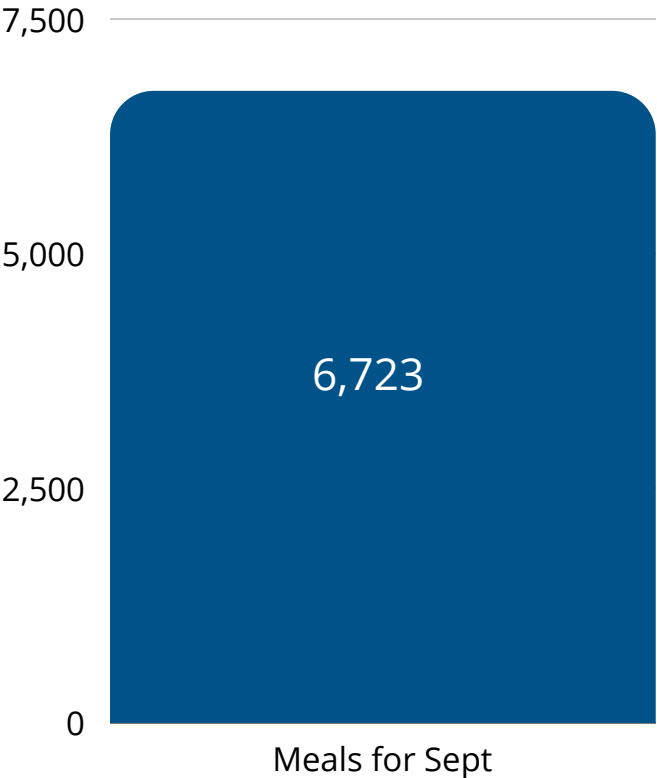
INCOME ELIGIBILITY

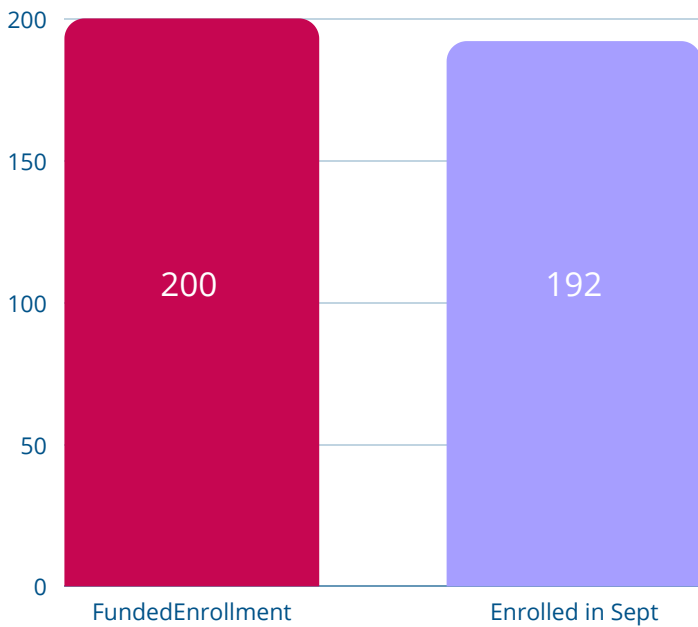

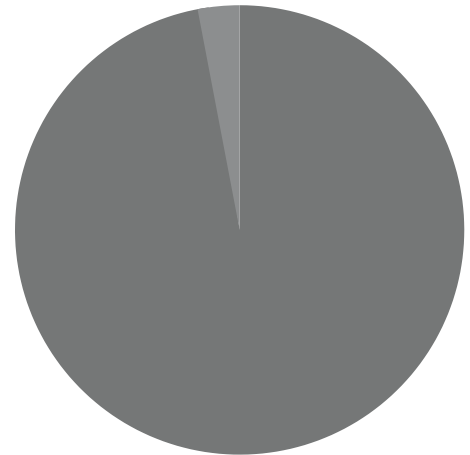

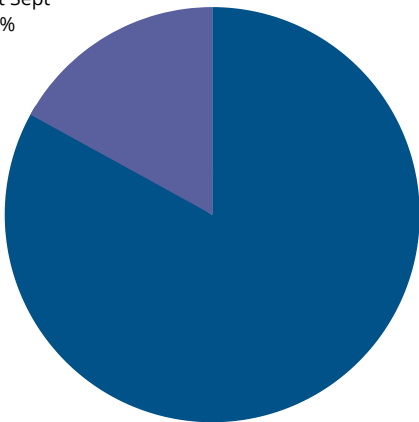

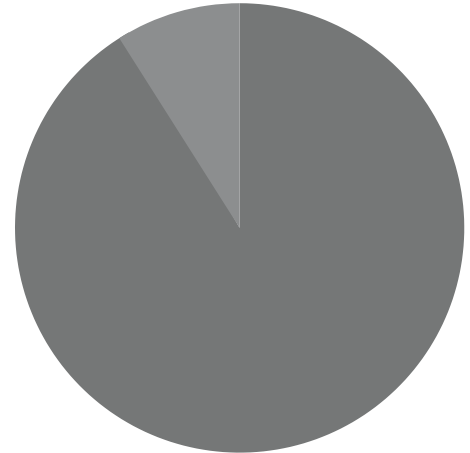

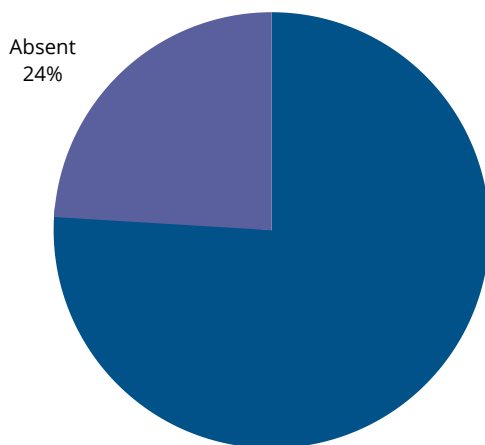

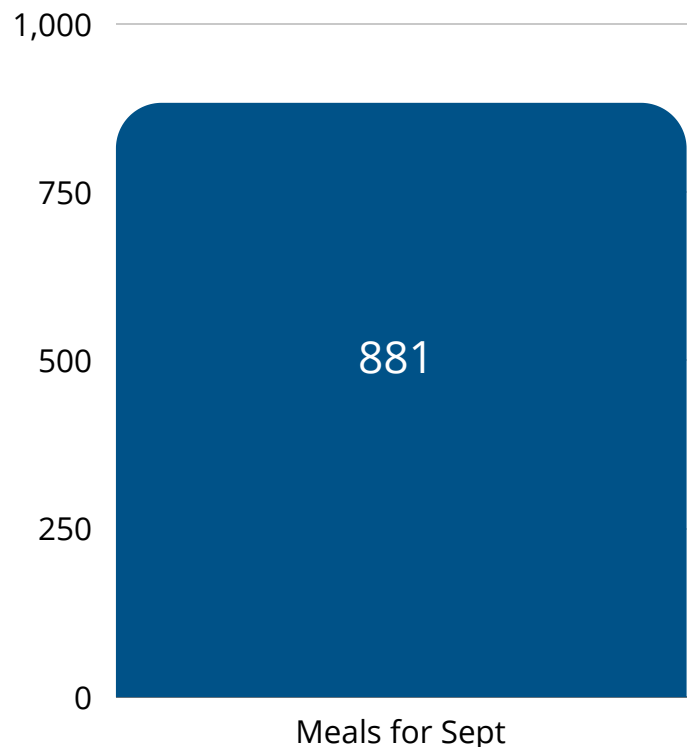

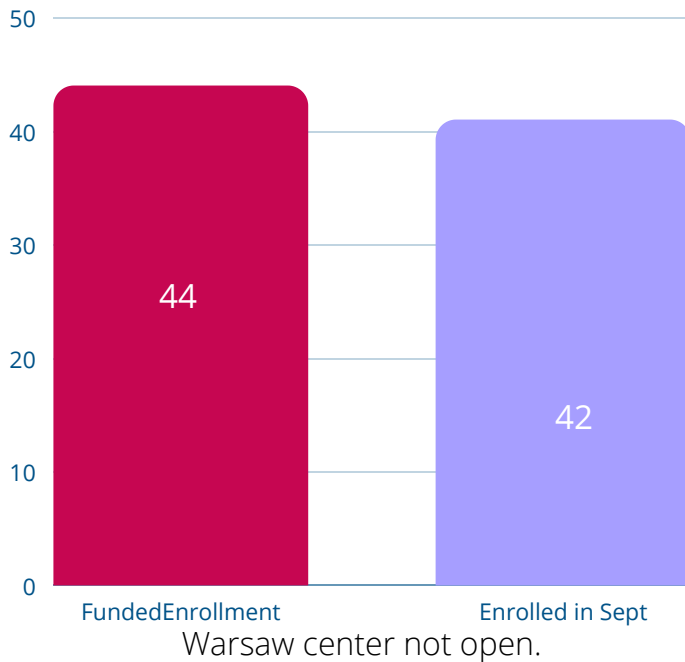

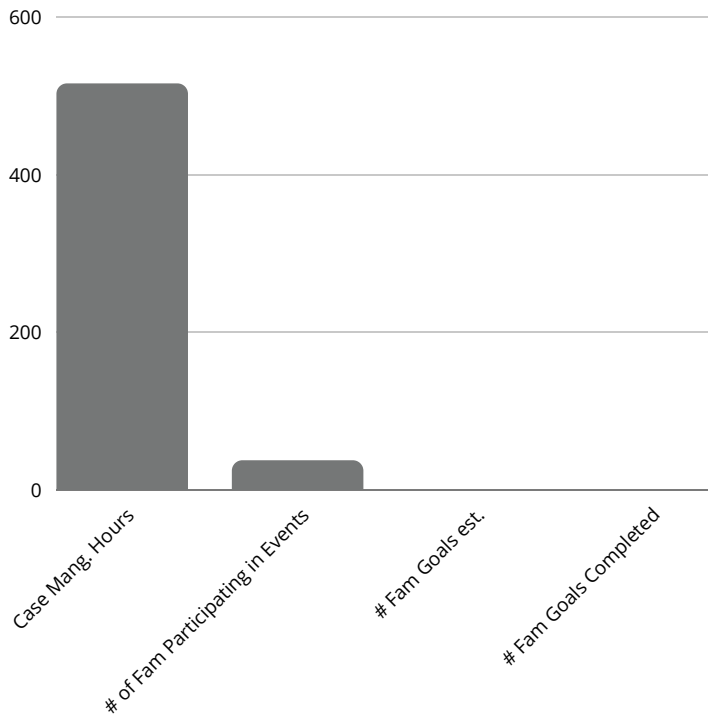
